Bee-Be Smith



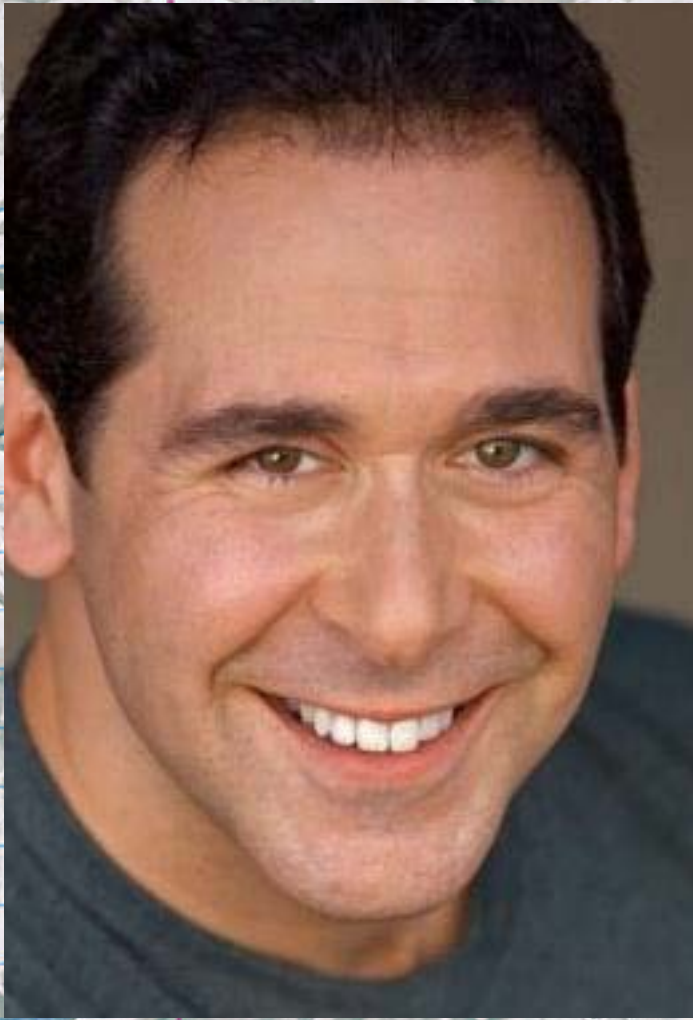

DIRECTOR'S NOTE/TONE

"Don't preach by example, lead by example". That was something that was missing in the original draft I read when I was offered to take on the director's chair for A 2nd Opinion. When I collaborated with David Gunning on his touching story, we wanted to make sure that this familiar formula had a fresh new voice and message behind it. We sat down and discussed how we didn't want to push any elements too far, or else we run the risk in making this story unbelievable. To the naked eye, Lillian, played by the brilliant and radiant Gabrielle Christian, would be a hard woman to relate to. So why would Gabriel, played with such control by David Gunning, still be interested? That was our true challenge in this story. We decided that if Gabriel was honestly attracted to Lillian, he wouldn't sit down and preach his views to contradict hers. In order to get one's true perspective, you must test instead of sermonize. What does one do once they're tested? That is when their true character reveals itself.
